The [Lewisville Independent School District](#) encompasses 127 square miles and serves the Town of Flower Mound, along with Lewisville, The Colony, Highland Village, Double Oak, Copper Canyon, Hebron, the northern portion of Carrollton and the western portion of Plano, as well as portions of Frisco, Coppell, Grapevine and Argyle. LISD is the 27th largest school district in the State of Texas, fully accredited at all grade levels (K-12) by the Texas Education Agency. All three high schools are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.
