- 2. <u>Municipal Judge-</u> Consider approval of an ordinance to reappoint Municipal Judge Jeff Tasker for the period of January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2022.
- 3. <u>CoServ Rate Case Suspension-</u> Consider approval of a resolution suspending the January 23, 2021, effective date of CoServ Gas Ltd.'s requested rate increase in order for the Town to study the request with other cities in the service area.
- 4. <u>1st Crime District Budget Amendment-</u> Town Council acting as the Board of Directors for the Town of Flower Mound Crime Control and Prevention District to consider approval of a resolution amending the Town of Flower Mound Crime Control and Prevention District budget for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2020, and ending on September 30, 2021, as adopted by Resolution No. 19-20.

- 6. <u>Lift Station Improvements Design Award-</u> Consider approval of a Professional Services Agreement for the design phase services for the Lift Station Improvements and Decommissioning Phase III project, with Plummer, Inc., for \$48,700.00; and authorization for the Mayor to execute same on behalf of the Town.
- 7. <u>Engine 502 repair-</u> Consider approval to ratify the expenditure of additional costs for parts and labor on Engine 502/Fleet #63000-05.
- 8. Oak Street Lift Station Design Award- Consider approval of a Professional Services Agreement for the design phase services for the Oak Street Lift Station and Force Main Phase IV project, with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., for \$330,500.00; and authorization for the Mayor to execute same on behalf of the Town.

11. <u>TIRZ 2020 Annual Report-</u> Consider approval of the 2020 Annual Report for the Flower Mound Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone #1 (TIRZ #1) in accordance with Chapter 311 of the Texas Tax Code (The TIRZ #1 Board approved by a vote of 3 to 0 at it's December 17, 2020, meeting)

J. REGULAR ITEMS

- 12. <u>ZPD20-0005 Niagara Conservation-</u> Public Hearing to consider an ordinance amending the zoning (ZPD20-0005 Niagara Conservation) from an Agricultural (A) Zoning district to Planned Development District No.179 (PD-179) with Campus Industrial uses, with certain waivers, exceptions and modifications to the Code of Ordinances. The property is generally located north of Enterprise Road and east of Old Gerault Road. (The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of the rezoning request and denial of the exception request to Section 82-376 of the Town Code that requires overhead utilities to be placed underground, by a vote of 6 to 0 at its November 9, 2020, meeting.) (The Town Council moved to postpone this item by a vote of 4 to 1 at its December 7, 2020, meeting.)
- 13. TRP20-0021 Niagara Conservation- Public Hearing to consider an application for a tree removal permit for twenty-five (25) specimen trees on property proposed for development as Niagara Conservation. The property is generally located north of Enterprise Road and east of Old Gerault Road. (The Environmental Conservation Commission recommended approval by a vote of 4-3-0 at its November 4, 2020, meeting. The Town Council moved to postpone this item by a vote of 4 to 1 at its December 7, 2020, meeting.)
- 14. Reinvestment Zone-300 Old Gerault Rd.- Public Hearing to consider approval of an ordinance establishing a Tax Abatement Reinvestment Zone for commercial tax abatement at 300 Old Gerault Road (Niagara Conservation, Inc., aka Deus, LLC). (The Town Council moved to postpone this item by a vote of 4 to 1 at its December 7, 2020, meeting.)
- 15. <u>Niagara Conserv. Ch 380 & Tax Abatement-</u> Public Hearing to consider approval of a Chapter 380 and Tax Abatement Agreement with Niagara Conservation, Inc. (aka Deus, LLC), for the economic development of Flower Mound, and authorization for the Mayor to execute same on behalf of Town. (The Town Council moved to postpone this item by a vote of 4 to 1 at its December 7, 2020, meeting.)
- 16. <u>Land Use Assumptions & Impact Fee Update-</u> **Public Hearing** to consider the approval of an ordinance adopting updated land use assumptions and updated capital improvements plans, and to update and amend certain provisions of Chapter 42, "Impact Fees," regarding the imposition of impact fees and amending Appendix A, "Fee Schedule", accordingly. (The CIAC recommended approval by a vote of 9 to 0 at its November 9, 2020, meeting.)(This item was postponed to January 4, 2021 at the December 7, 2020 Town Council meeting)
- 17. Morriss Road Water Line Ph2 Construction—Consider approval of a Construction Agreement with Excel Aircraft LLC, dba Excel Trenching, for the Morriss Road Water Lines Phase II (FM 1171 to Eaton) project, in the amount of \$2,249,151.00; and authorization for the Mayor to execute same on behalf of the Town.

Applicant requests to postpone items 12 – 15 to Feb. 1 18. <u>SP20-0013 Argyle ISD Admin Building-</u> Consider a request for a Site Plan (SP20-0013 – Argyle ISD Administration Building) to develop a school administration building with an exception to Section IV, Storm Water Improvements, regarding use of an open channel storm sewer, contained in the Town's Engineering Design Criteria and Construction Standards adopted through Chapter 32 of the Code of Ordinances. The property is generally located east of Canyon Falls Drive and north of Denton Creek Boulevard. (The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval by a vote of 6 to 0 at its December 14, 2020, meeting.)
