**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** This work session item provides the Environmental Conservation Commission (ECC) the opportunity to review and discuss the initial findings from the tree preservation subcommittee related to specimen tree designations.

The ECC formed the arboretum/tree preservation subcommittee in 2019 to review options for an arboretum and evaluate the Town's tree preservation regulations. Commission Member Soper-Pinkelman began evaluating tree survey data for various development projects in the Town. The information being discussed during the work session will provide the ECC an opportunity to assess the current specimen tree sizes and discuss potential preservation options moving forward.
