

# **HERITAGE PARK SPLASH PAD RULES**

AN ADULT MUST ACCOMPANY CHILDREN UNDER 12 IN THE SPLASH PAD PLAY AREA.

PLEASE USE THE SPLASH PAD AT YOUR OWN RISK.

ATTENDANT IS NOT ON DUTY.

IN CASE OF THUNDERSTORM, LIGHTNING OR SEVERE WEATHER, VACATE THE SPLASH PAD IMMEDIATELY.

ALL TOWN OF FLOWER MOUND PARKS ARE TOBACCO FREE, INCLUDING ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES.

DO NOT USE SPLASH PAD IF YOU FEEL ILL, HAVE A CONTAGIOUS DISEASE, OR HAVE HAD DIARRHEA IN THE PAST WEEK.

No running, roughhousing or profane language permitted.

This splash pad uses treated, recirculated water. DO NOT DRINK OR PUT WATER IN YOUR MOUTH AND SPIT. A drinking fountain is provided at the public restroom building.

Infants and toddlers must wear a swim diaper. Diapers to be changed in restroom only.

Food, glass and drinks are not permitted within the splash pad area.

No skateboards, bicycles, scooters or similar recreation equipment allowed in the park.

Strollers and wheelchairs are permitted.

Proper attire must be worn at all times. All apparel must be clean prior to entering the play area. Footwear is recommended.

For your safety, do not obstruct water features, climb on boulder, or climb or swing on the splash pad equipment.

No pets allowed inside the splash pad area.

Toys, water balloons, beach balls, pool noodles, buckets, and water guns are not permitted.

No bathing, soap, detergent, or shampoo allowed.

No climbing on the fence.

INDIVIDUALS ENGAGED IN UNSAFE OR DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SPLASH PLAY AREA.
