

Art Showcase & Contest Rules for FloMo MiniCon 2022

ART SHOWCASE SPECIFICATIONS:

- Artwork must be inspired by anime, manga or traditional comics
- Limit one entry per person
- Minimum size: 4x6 inches. Maximum size 24x30 inches
- Artwork must be two-dimensional and completely dry (if working with a medium such as chalk, please make sure to seal work with a proper fixative)
- Unfortunately, sculpture and other three-dimensional work cannot be accepted (some texture is allowable; however, it must be able to be hung for display)
- Work should be mounted on mat board, foam core, or some other sturdy material
- Unframed submissions are preferred, but framed work will be accepted
- Artwork must be completely original and suitable for viewing by all ages
- Deadline to submit art for showcase display is **FRIDAY, JANUARY 7, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.**
- FloMo MiniCon 2022 is **SATURDAY, JANUARY 15 from 12-4PM**; you don't have to attend to participate in the artist showcase

ART CONTEST SPECIFIC RULES:

- Your submission will be a picture of your artwork that will be displayed online for the public to vote on (the picture will be taken of your real-life submission by the teen librarian)
- You must submit your artwork by the deadline **FRIDAY, JANUARY 7, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.**
- The art contest will run from **JANUARY 10, 2022 at 12:00 PM through JANUARY 14, 2022 at 5:00 PM** through an online Google Form
- The highest voted artwork in each category will be selected as the winners
- There will be two winners: (1) Middle School Winner, and (2) High School/Young Adult Winner
- Winners will receive a special prize at MiniCon on **SATURDAY, JANUARY 15 from 12-4PM**
- You don't have to enter the art contest to have your work displayed in the artist showcase

Rules are subject to change and interpretation of these rules is at the discretion of the Flower Mound Public Library staff members. The Library reserves the right to not display submissions based on appropriateness and space considerations.
