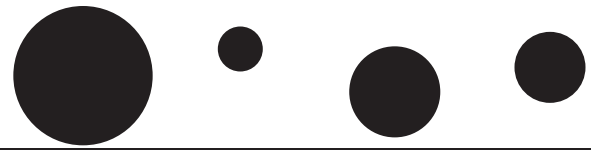


Aquatic Rules



BASIC SAFETY TIPS

We encourage each child to have a buddy for the duration of your visit. Groups should announce periodic “buddy checks” and account for everyone in your groups. A colored wristband may also be helpful in locating members of your group quickly.

First Aid is administered at the First Aid Office. Ask a pool staff member where to go if you are unsure.

Designate a meeting area which will be attended at all times by one of your staff members so your children can find a recognizable adult at any time.

WEATHER/CLOSURE POLICY

When both the Outdoor Waterpark and Indoor Aquatics are closed due to weather or for other unforeseen circumstances, customers who have been in the facility for less than 2 hours will receive a rain check for each day pass purchased.

AQUATIC AREA GROUP SAFETY GUIDELINES

The Flower Mound Community Activity Center is a safety first facility. Please read the following safety guidelines in order to have a safe and fun experience while at the CAC.

- **Message to Parents and Supervisors:** Please come to the pool prepared to get into the water with your non-swimmers. We are not staffed to provide individual supervision. Our rules will allow you to be safe and have fun at the same time.
- **The CAC staff will access the ratio of non-swimmers to supervisors in your party.** Please be prepared to get into the water with children 8 years of age or younger or make appropriate arrangements prior to your arrival. We will not allow children into the pool area unless the below criteria are met.
- Groups/Agencies must carry information on all participants under their care. Also, parent/guardian consent to go swimming is also required. Our admission staff will check this information prior to entering the facility.
- Opposite gender children are not allowed in the men’s and women’s locker rooms. Please utilize the Family Locker Room for your convenience.
- Children 3 years of age and younger must be accompanied in the water within arms reach of a supervisor with a ratio of 2 children to 1 supervisor. Children 8 years of age and younger must be accompanied in the water by a supervisor with a ratio of 6 children to 1 supervisor. Children 9 years of age and older must be accompanied in the pool area by a supervisor with a ratio of 10 children to 1 supervisor.
- Children wearing lifejackets must be directly supervised within an arms length of a supervisor at all times.
- A child must be 42” in height to ride indoor waterslides and 48” in height to ride outdoor waterslides.
- Lifejackets are not permitted on indoor or outdoor waterslides. Adults/guardians are not allowed to catch children at the bottom of the slides.
- Users will not be able to bring in personal toys or devices with the exception of lifejackets. Lifejackets and flotation devices must be US Coast Guard approved.
- Swimmers who are not potty trained must wear a disposable swim diaper. These are available for purchase at the front desk.
- Alcohol and glass containers are not permitted. Ice chests are subject to search.
- Pool users must towel dry off completely before entering non-pool areas.
- All users must have a Family Atmosphere Swimsuit. No cutoffs, stretch shorts, or under garments.
- Please clean up your pool areas appropriately after your rental. Non-compliance will result in an appropriate cleaning fee.
